NO YEARLY on-going eye exams available for diabetic pts. The eligibility criterion: there needs to be SIGNICANT impairment in BOTH eyes. Each case needs to be screened individually by the Social Worker. Services currently available: job training, referral for Independent Living, laser or surgical treatment.
